Youth Radio Presenter Bootcamp - The 25th June saw another successful Sta Fm Bootcamp with Mal Really, along with the assistance of Elly Croft, hosting a 4 hour Youth Radio Bootcamp to 5 successful students from Ashford Central School. The students were given a behind-the-scenes tour, where they had the chance to witness live broadcasts, learn about radio production techniques, and gain insights into the daily operations of a studio environment. The visit builds on work the students have been completing in the classroom and is the first time the station has hosted students from Ashford Central School. Students were asked to research a local business and create their own 30-second advertisement which they rehearsed before having the opportunity to read on air. There was positive feedback from listeners tuning in and commenting that the students did a great job.

It was great to watch the students blossom throughout the day and a couple of them have indicated they are keen to return to do some work experience with Sta Fm. It's always fantastic to see young people keen to learn more about radio. Sta Fm enjoyed sharing their experience and passion for radio with the next generation of potential broadcasters.

Community radio provides a great pathway into media, marketing and communications. Ashford Central School's visit reinforces STA FM's commitment to fostering community involvement in the station and nurturing young talent in the media industry.
